Lockdown 2- Whole School Update

Dear Parents & Carers,

First of all, a huge thank you for your understanding regarding the school closure today. The task we have been given is immense and the timescale in which to produce a safe, coherent plan based upon information which we needed to gather was just impossible. That said, we are where we are and in true DJS spirit, staff have embraced the challenge and can share our preliminary plans with *you based upon the most up to date DFE guidance at the time of writing*.

We have over 50% of the school requiring a place for their child throughout the week and these numbers are not static, thus our numbers of pupils in school and working remotely will fluctuate each day- this makes providing a consistent, high quality education deal really challenging. Another challenge is that staff capacity is stretched. For example, with two thirds of the staff teaching face to face in school, there is less capacity to do remote/live lessons at home. We have thus prioritised the following principles in our decision-making (based on current Government guidance at the time of writing):

- 1. Bubbles in school to be of the same year group and not exceed 32 in size.
- 2. Pupils at **home and school** to complete the same curriculum and access the same resources/materials.
- 3. A clear expectation that children complete the work set and attend any remote meetings with teachers or staff.
- 4. Work to be differentiated or separately prepared for lower ability pupils and those on the SEND register (as appropriate).
- 5. The education provided to mirror the content and quantity typically taught in a school day.
- 6. Provide a system whereby pupils can receive feedback for their learning at home.
- 7. School to maintain safeguarding procedures through face to face teaching and remote meetings.
- 8. To maintain our current COVID 19 risk assessment for all pupils & staff in school.

- Children should wear their school uniform if attending school.
- Please note, parents and carers must not access the school grounds unless this has been prearranged. The usual drop off and pick up procedures will apply.
- The school kitchen will operate, but they may not be able to provide hot meals. Your child can

- order a lunch in the morning on arrival.
- Pupils will have two new exercise books. One that remains in school and one to bring home if they are not attending school every day.

Pupils Learning Remotely at Home

Attached is our updated <u>Remote Education Policy</u>. This will give the full details of our offer and what you can expect your child to receive. All children may collect a new exercise book from the school office for their remote education during this period. They can complete all tasks/stick in sheets etc into this book if they wish. They will be in a box in the reception area ready for collection Wednesday 6th January.
