L.O: To identify persuasive features in a letter

Persuasive Technique	Can you find an example? Tick or cross	Evidence
<u>Rhetorical question</u> A question to make the reader think not actually answer	Yes	You colour with me but why?
<u>Exaggeration</u> A point which is exaggerated	Yes	If I didn't have a black outline you wouldn't even know I'm here
<u>Points supported with examples</u> When the writer backs up their point with evidence	Yes	I'm only used to colour snow or to fill in empty spaces between other things.
<u>Emotive language</u> When the writer shares their feelings with the reader	Yes	And it leaves me feeling empty
<u>Addressing the reader</u> Using you/your	Yes	You colour with me but why? You wouldn't even know I'm there
<u>Repetition</u> Points repeated more than once	Yes	To fill in empty spaces It leaves my feeling empty Your empty friend

<u>Rhetorical question</u> A question to make the reader think not actually answer	No	
<u>Exaggeration</u> A point which is exaggerated	Yes	All year long I wear myself out
<u>Points supported with examples</u> When the writer backs up their point with evidence	Yes	I even work on holidays. I have to colour all the santas at Christmas and the hearts on Valentines day!
<u>Emotive language</u> When the writer shares their feelings with the reader	Yes	I NEED A REST!
<u>Addressing the reader</u> Using you/your	Yes	You make me work harder
<u>Repetition</u> Points repeated more than once	Yes	Work harder than any of your crayons Over worked friend I even work on holidays
