



The Day the Crayons Quit Challenge

Red- Give Red a break. Don't use it very much and you may not use it for fire trucks, Santa, strawberries, apples, or hearts!

Purple- Purple insists that you have GOOD CRAFTSMANSHIP, so try to color as nice and neat as possible.

Beige- Help beige feel better about himself. Use Beige to make at least one of these items: bear, pony, or puppy.

Gray- Poor Gray is tired so use him to make something small like a penguin or rock. For an added challenge you need to pick a rhino, whale, hippo, or elephant and color it with something other than Gray.

White- Help white feel good about himself. Don't leave any unimportant White space. That means your ENTIRE paper needs to be colored in and it can only be White if it is something that is supposed to be White.

Black- Black does not want to be used for any outlines. Use Black to draw a couple objects that are colored in with Black.

Green- Green loves coloring crocodiles, trees, dinosaurs and frogs, so pick at least two of these things to add to your drawing.

Orange and **Yellow**- Orange and Yellow can't agree who is the color of the sun so use BOTH equally to create a sunset in your drawing.

Blue- Stubby little blue needs a break. So don't use him to color oceans, lakes, rivers, raindrops, rainclouds, or the clear sky.

Pink- Pink wants to be used to color a dinosaur, monster, or cowboy so be sure to include one in your drawing.

Peach- Peach is so embarrassed that he doesn't want to come out of the crayon box, so sorry NO Peach in your drawing.
