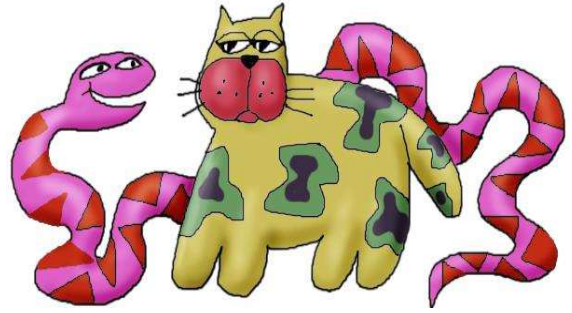


## WORD SWAPPING
