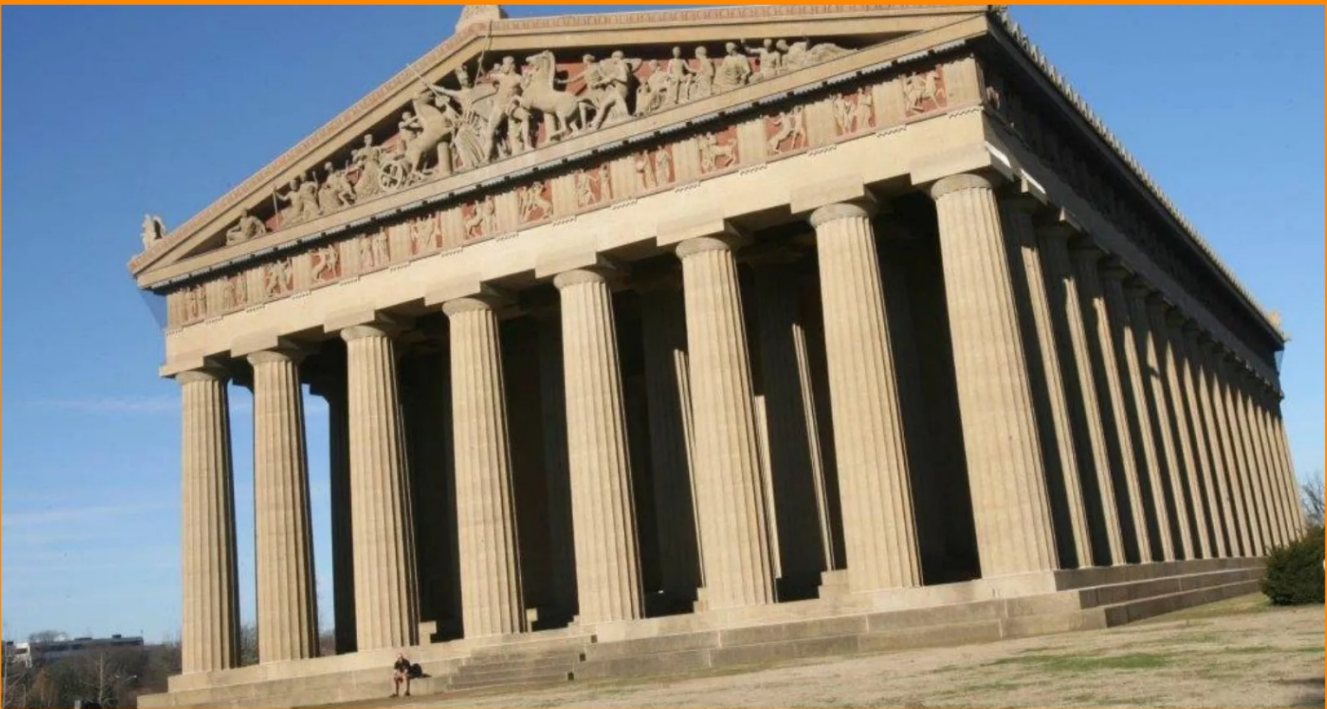
The Parthenon

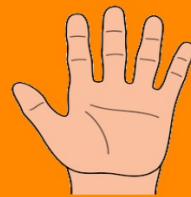

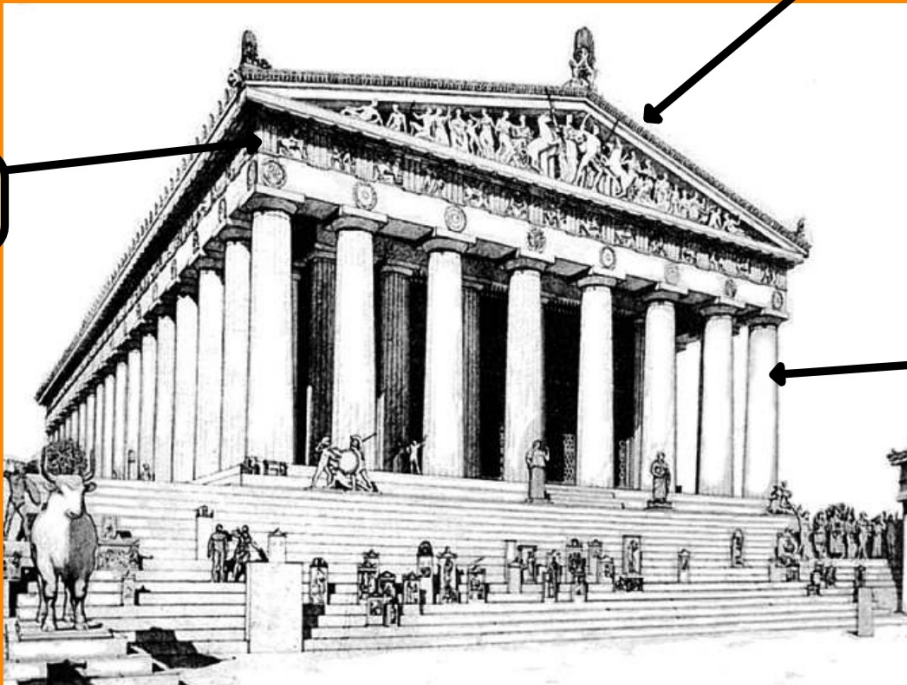

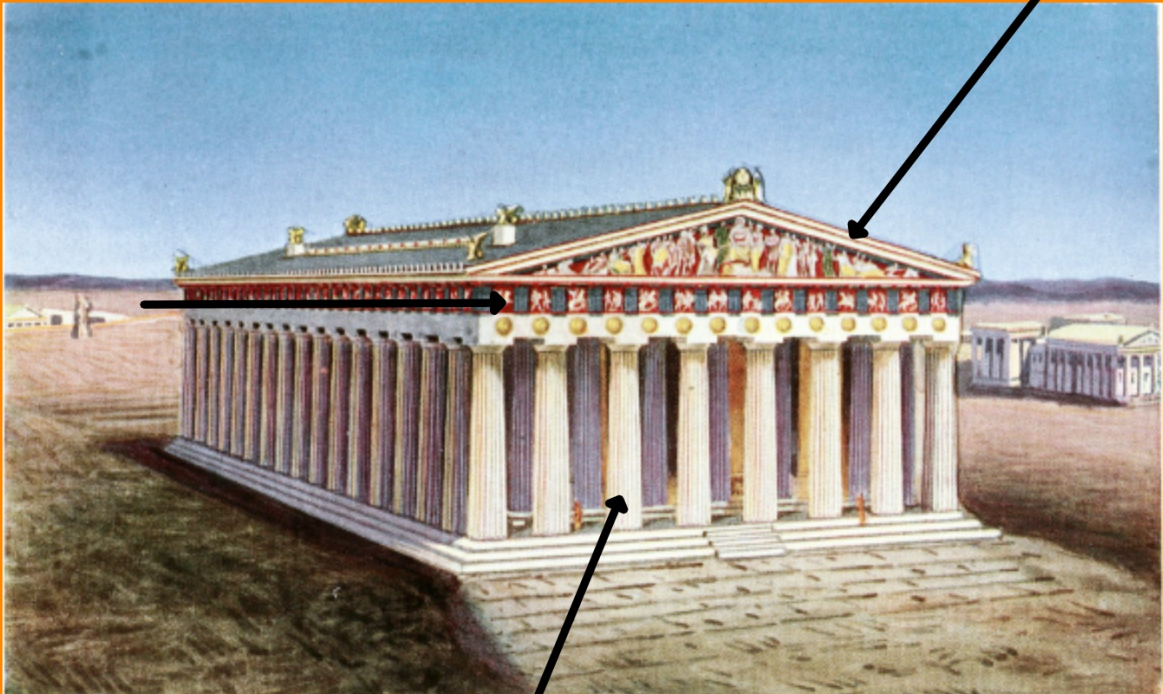
