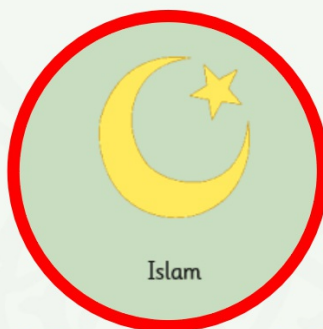


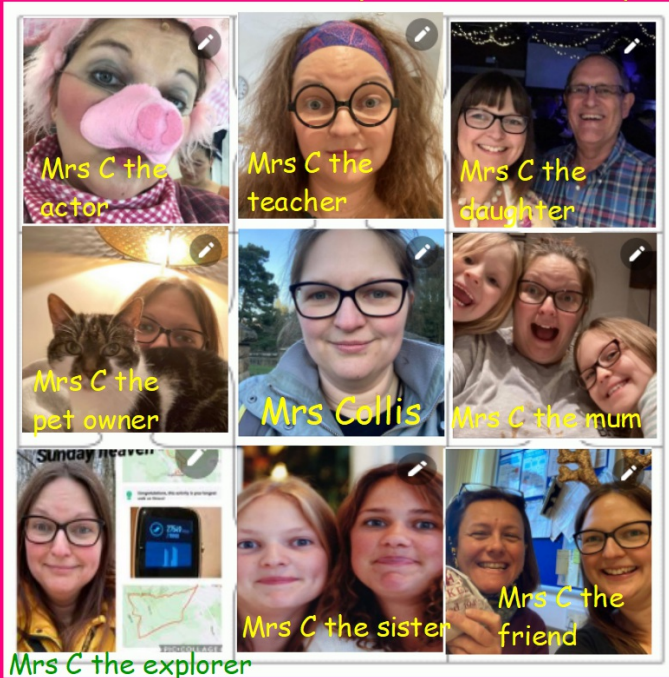


Hindus believe in one supreme god called Brahman.

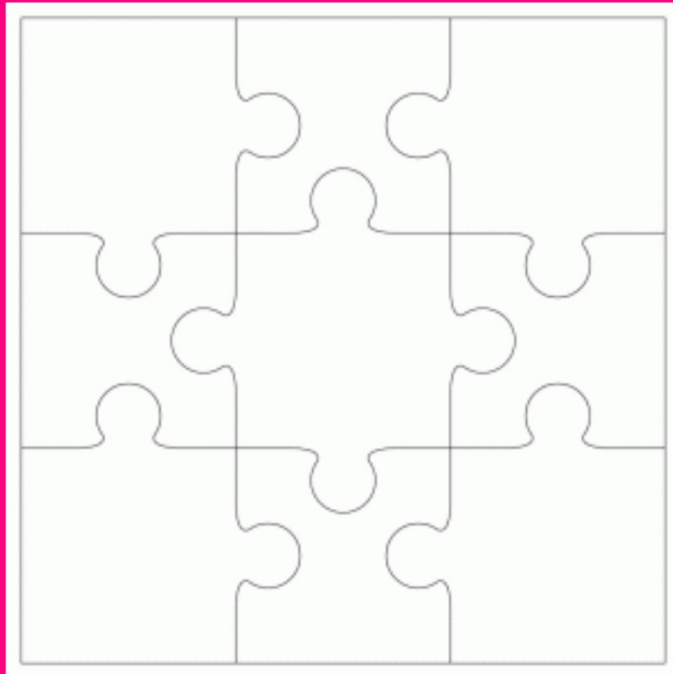

It is necessary to do the right thing at all times.

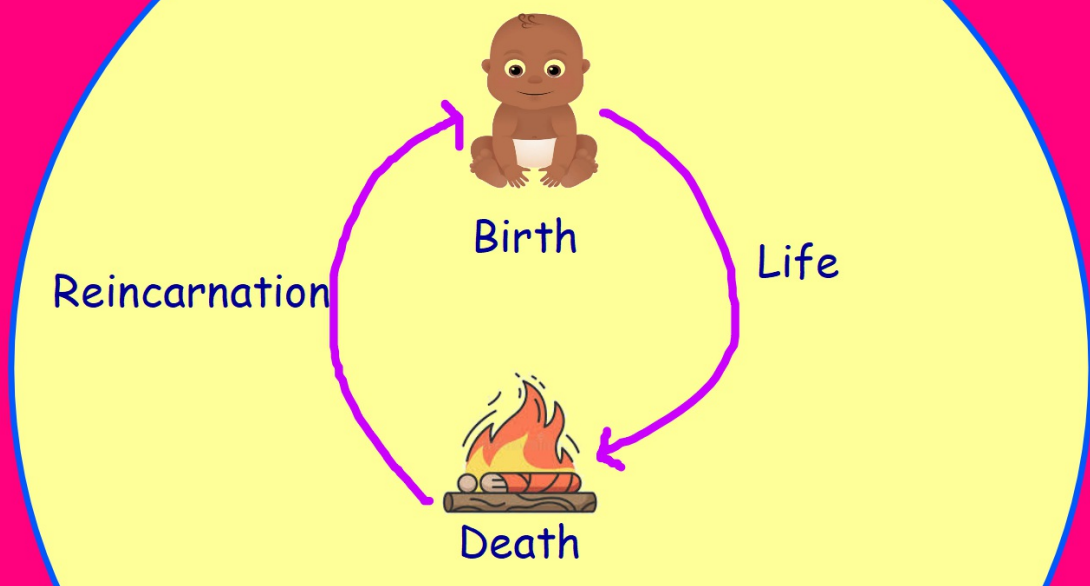


## Reincarnation

## **Moksha**

Hindus believe that ultimate goal is being freed from reincarnation.

This is when your soul reunites with Brahman.
