Home Learning

<u>The details for the home learning each week</u> <u>will be published on the class story of</u> <u>ClassDojo</u>. Each week, children will be set a spelling task plus English or Maths work from their CPG books. Year 4 homework should take no longer than 40 minutes a week (including practising spellings). We also ask that children read at home at least three times a week.

Spellings – every half term a spelling overview will be put onto ClassDojo class story. Every week your child will have up to ten spellings to learn that follow a certain spelling rule.
