Love is patient, love is kind.

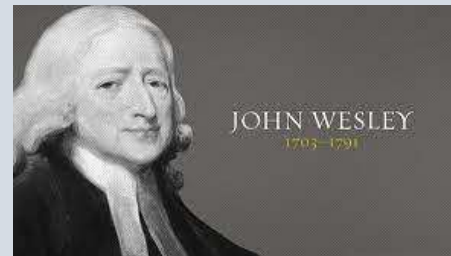
It does not envy,
