Architecture	The carefully designed structure of a building
Tools	A device used to carry out a particular function.
Progress	Improvements that move something forwards.
Achievements	A thing done successfully with effort, skill or courage.

Spirituality	Someone's religious values or feelings of being connected to a higher power e.g. a god.
