Dear Parents/Carers,

We are planning to take the Year 6 children to a Crucial Crew event on **Monday January 20th 2025.** 

The event is organised by South Yorkshire Police at the Lifewise Centre in Rotherham. Children will experience a series of real-life situations, learn how to deal with them and how to make a 999 call. Scenarios previously have included fire in the home, a traffic accident, hazards in the home and how to deal with issues online and with strangers. It is intended specifically for Y6 children as they begin to make the transition to secondary school.

We will be travelling by coach and children need to be at school by **8.20am**, so that we can aim to leave by **8:30am**. We hope to be back at school by 3:30pm. You will be informed by text if we are delayed.

A packed lunch is needed (no glass bottles, nuts or fizzy drinks please) and children may also bring a snack. School uniform must be worn, but as we are indoors all day there should be no need for a waterproof coat as we will only be walking to and from the coach.

The Lifewise Centre does not charge for the trip, however, we need a 'voluntary contribution' of £9.20 per child for the visit to go ahead.

Governors have agreed that: The charge of this visit includes a voluntary contribution. We would be happy to provide you with a breakdown of costs on request. You will appreciate that this visit will only go ahead if we receive the full charge including the voluntary contribution. Thank you.
