- It will also be something that they are able to look forward to at the end of Year 6, as well as a lovely final adventure for them before they move to secondary school.

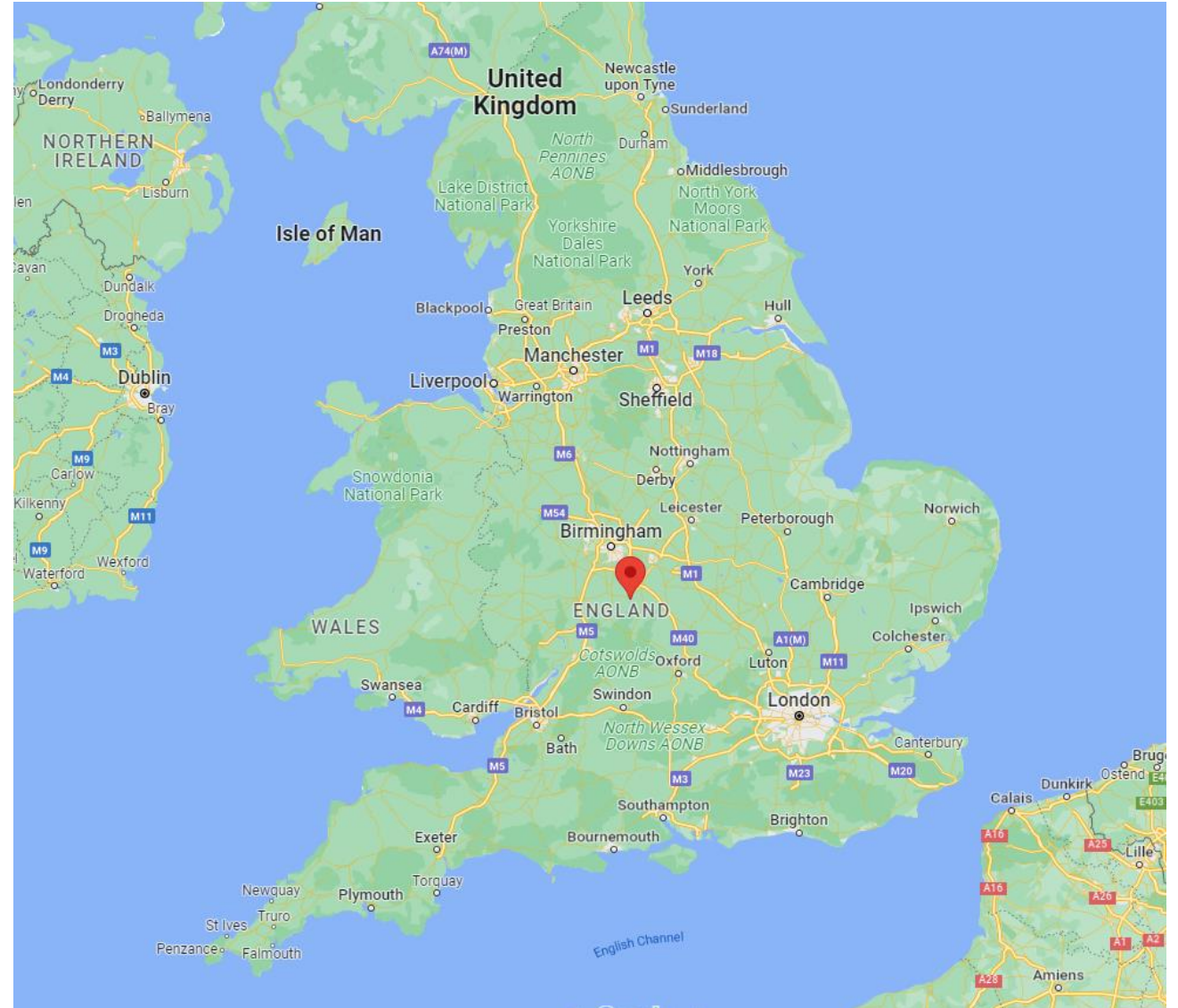
# Why a residential trip?

# Where is Stratford?

It's in the county of Warwickshire, and is just south of Birmingham.

We'll travel by coach and head down the M1 to get there.



# Accommodation

- We'll be staying in the Stratford Youth Hostel, which is a couple of miles outside of the town itself.
- Our coach will be with us all week, so we won't have too many tired legs from walking there and back though!



# Accommodation

- Children will sleep in single gender dormitory-style accommodation - with either single or bunk beds.
- Sharing a room with others and organising themselves day-by-day will support the children's learning in citizenship and personal development.



# Meals



- Meals will be provided by the youth hostel, either in their dining room, or as a packed lunch on days out.
- They will provide choice and variety and, of course, be able to cater for a range of dietary requirements.

- They will have a tour of the town, which will both help them explore the Tudor History of the place, but also visit a different locality to Sheffield - supporting geography learning.
