Home Learning

Every Friday, we will communicate home learning via ClassDojo. Homework comprises of a Maths or SPaG activity plus spelling, times tables and reading. Home learning books should be returned to school every Wednesday.

Weekly spellings will be posted alongside a half termly overview. Children should practice little and often throughout the week.

Children should be reading as much as possible at home. They must have their reading records signed three times a week by an adult at home please. Reading records should be in school everyday. (Top Tip - store them in school rucksacks!)

Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

The MTC is a statutory key stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of Year 4 (in June). The MTC's purpose is to ensure the times tables knowledge is at the expected level. The MTC is an online test where the pupils are asked 25 questions on a range of times tables from 2 to 12. For every question, you have 6 seconds to answer, and in between the questions, there is a 3-second rest. Questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times table come up more often. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC.

At school, we are helping children prepare by helping them learn and embedd their multiplication facts. This needs to be reinforced at home. <u>IT Rockstars</u>, <u>Hit The Button</u> or <u>URBrainy MTC</u> are all good websites to help them. We will be sending out more information about this assessment in Summer term.
