- the g clamp.
- 2. Hold the saw in one hand with your thumb on the top.
- 3. Use the other hand to push the wood gently up against the bench hook.
- 4. Pull the saw back three times.
- 5. Gently, saw backwards and forwards, keeping the saw straight.
