

Vocabulary	
Ancient	A period of history from the beginning of writing to the fall of the Roman Empire (476 AD). The very distant past.
Civilisation	A society, culture and way of life in a particular area and time period.
Diversity	Having lots of variety e.g. people from a variety of background, races and religions.
Social Class	Where you are in society based on how much money you earn.
Achievements	A thing done successfully with effort, skill or courage.
Legacy	Something that is part of history and remains from an earlier time.
Spirituality	Someone's religious values or feelings of being connected to a higher power e.g. a god.
Kingdom	A country or area of land ruled over by a king or queen.
Pyramid	A huge structure with sloping sides that meet at the top in a point.
Hieroglyphs	Characters or symbols (pictures) used in writing instead of letters.
Mummification	The process of preserving a dead body as a mummy.
Construction	The action of building something, typically a large structure.
Pharaoh	A ruler in ancient Egypt - their equivalent of a king or queen.
Irrigation	The supply of water to land to help crops go by using channels.
