World Book Day: Thursday 6th March

To celebrate and encourage a lifelong love of reading we are celebrating **World Book Day** on **Thursday 6th March**.

The aim of the day is to share a love of books with the children and introduce them to different authors and genres. We are inviting children to **bring their favourite book into school** and wear **comfy clothes (such as PJs)** so that they can spend time reading and discussing books with their peers. They will be taking part in a range of book-based activities from story time to quizzes.

Book Fair: Tuesday 4th March & Thursday 6th March

On Tuesday 4th March and Thursday 6th March after school, we will be holding a book fair in the hall from 3:30pm – 4:15pm hosted by the 'Travelling Book Company'. The hall can be accessed from the back playground – your child should be able to guide you there!

All the money raised from the book fair will go towards brand new books for our school. The more we sell, the more books we can claim. Last year we raised a fantastic £729: can we beat that this year? Payments for the books can be cash or via a cashless QR code.

Please note, the Travelling Book Company only send 3 copies of each book, but if a certain book is extremely popular, this can be ordered and will be delivered on Monday 10th March.
