Your task is to produce a short, non-fiction text all about spring. It can be presented however you like - anything from a leaflet to a poster. You can use a computer if you wish.

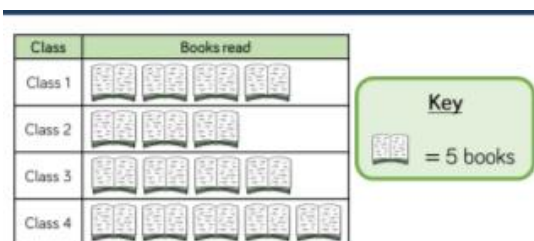
Here are some ideas:

LO: To create a Pictogram

If you have Lego at home randomly select 30 pieces (a couple of handfuls will do) and create a tally chart - like the last Maths task - on the colour of each piece. Once you have created your tally chart, use this information to create a pictogram showing the different colours. Here is a WAGOLL of a pictogram.



Success Criteria:

- A pictogram must have a key to show the value of the picture
- A pictogram is laid out like a table, with 2 columns and the rows showing the data collected
- Remember Pictograms must have the same picture for each colour

Here is a scaffolded version for those who may need additional support:

Colour of Lego piece	Number of that colour
Red	
Yellow	
Blue	

If you want a **challenge**, you can increase the number of Lego pieces you choose from and on your pictogram. Or for a **Super Challenge** you can increase the number each picture represents so that you have to draw half or quarter pictures. Please record on a piece of paper and email to your teacher so they can see how you've got on.

If you do not have Lego at home: you can choose any number of objects such as books (front colour cover), toys or even flowers outside.
