2. Write a new ending for the book. Decide what you would change and write two to three paragraphs.

3. Draw a picture of a character in your book and write down all of the words the author used to describe them.
Can you add any more?

4. Summarise (in your own words) the main event in the story.

5. Create your favourite scene from the book in lego or junk modelling

6. Make a list of five titles that you think would make a better name for your book.

7. Write what you think about the main character in your story.

8. Write a letter as a character in your book to another character in your book.

9. Draw a picture of your favourite part in the book.

10. Create a video advertising your book. How would you persuade people to read it?

11. Draw a poster advertising your book.

12. Design a new cover for the book (use a computer if you can!). Think carefully about the picture you choose.

13. Write your own blurb for the book.

14. Summarise an event from the story from the main character's point of view.

15. Write a letter to the author telling them why you liked or didn't like the book.
