

Newspaper report success criteria

<u>Newspaper report text features</u>	<u>SPaG features</u>
Headline e.g. LIGHTHOUSE MIRACLE	Conjunctions to link ideas (Look at the WAGOLL words)
My standfirst sets the scene with the five Ws; Where? Why? Who? What? When?	Informal and formal tone (Some parts chatty, some parts not so chatty).
My byline includes the name of the author and date	Adverbials (describing where, when and how)
I have included a photo with a caption	Passive voice <i>The lighthouse has been saved by the villagers.</i>
The events are in chronological order and contain facts	Rhetorical questions <i>Did this save the boat?</i>
It is in the past tense was were had	Punctuation . A ? ! , () ; : - " "
I have used the third person The man The lighthouse The villagers	
I have included quotes from witnesses The guard of the lighthouse said: "It was an absolute miracle- I couldn't believe what I was seeing."	
My closing statement brings the writing to a conclusion <i>Let's hope this does not happen in the future.</i>
