

Handprint Rudolph Christmas Card

You will need:

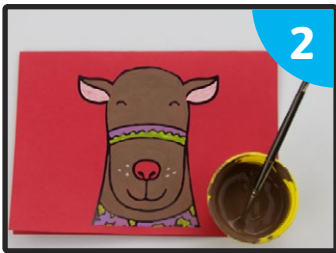
- Rudolph Card Template
- Small red pom-pom
- Brown paint
- Paintbrush
- Felt-tip Pens
- 2 pieces of coloured card (A4)
- Plate or tray for paint



- White glue
- Scissors



1 In preparation, print the Rudolph template onto a piece of coloured card. Fold along the dotted line, then lay the card horizontal and flat ready for painting.



2 Now, colour in Rudolph's face using either paint or felt-tip pens.



3 To create Rudolph's bright red nose, stick on a red pom-pom, using white glue.



4 Now, make Rudolph's antlers! To do this, use the paint brush to cover your left hand in brown paint. Then, carefully print your hand on to the spare piece of card. Repeat this with your right hand, then leave to dry.



5 Once dry, use scissors to cut out both handprints.



Now, stick both handprints onto the top of Rudolph's head, so that the thumbs are on the inside. To do this, turn the handprints over, so that the painted side is facing down. Then, spread a little glue onto the reverse of each handprint, before placing them in position and gently pressing them down.



Once the card is dry, you can write a message inside.

Handprint Rudolph Christmas Card

You will need:

- Rudolph Card Template
- Small red pom-pom
- Brown paint
- Paintbrush
- Felt-tip Pens
- 2 pieces of coloured card (A4)
- Plate or tray for paint
- White glue
- Scissors





Step 1

In preparation, print the Rudolph template onto a piece of coloured card. Fold along the dotted line, then lay the card horizontal and flat ready for painting.



Step 2

Now, colour in Rudolph's face using either paint or felt-tip pens.



Step 3

To create Rudolph's bright red nose, stick on a red pom-pom, using white glue.



Step 4

Now, make Rudolph's antlers! To do this, use the paint brush to cover your left hand in brown paint. Then, carefully print your hand on to the spare piece of card. Repeat this with your right hand, then leave to dry.



Step 5

Once dry, use scissors to cut out both handprints.



Step 6

Now, stick both handprints onto the top of Rudolph's head, so that the thumbs are on the inside. To do this, turn the handprints over, so that the painted side is facing down. Then, spread a little glue onto the reverse of each handprint, before placing them in position and gently pressing them down.



Step 7

Once the card is dry, you can write a message inside.
