

LO - To write a persuasive text (1st Draft)

The aim for your writing today is to try and make the notes you have made in your planning join together through cohesion. An example is as follows.

Parents will love it!

- Car park close
- Toilets
- Baby Change

Our wildlife park is fantastically convenient for a family day out - meaning that both parents and children will love it! Firstly, our **car park is close** to the adventure meaning that it's only a short stroll to get to the animals.
