Dictionary Entry

plumber noun

A person whose job is to fit and repair things such as water pipes, toilets, etc.

*I think we'll have to call the **plumber** to fix that tap.*

wooden adjective

To be made of wood.

*The karts were **wooden**.*

fast adverb

To move quickly.

*She drove **fast** in her kart.*

fast adjective

Moving or capable of moving at high speed.

*He won as he had a **fast** bike while my car was too slow.*

Use the different colours shown these parts of each entry:

- The word = yellow
- The word class = green
- A definition = blue
- An example sentence = pink

The first has been done for you.

Revision Card – Word Classes

Multiple word classes

Look at how Mario and Luigi are using the word 'click'.



I heard a loud
click.

noun

verb

I will **click** my
fingers loudly.



Are they the same word class?

No! One is a verb and the other is a noun.

Multiple word classes

What about the word 'hard'?



This is a super
hard piece of
cheese!

adjective

I find swimming
very **hard** to do.

adverb



Are they the same word class?

No! One is an adverb and the other is an adjective.
