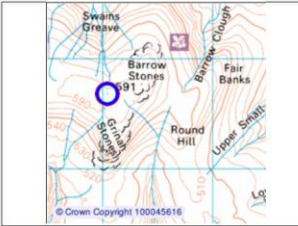




source
The place where a river starts, normally in an upland area. It may be a lake, a marsh, a spring or a glacier.



meander
A curve or bend in the course of a stream or river.



river mouth
The place where a river flows into a lake, reservoir, sea or ocean.



waterfall
A cascade of water falling from a height, formed when a river or stream flows over a precipice.



river channel
The area a river flows in with banks at the sides.



reservoir
An enlarged natural or manmade lake, normally created using a dam, used to store water.



tributary
A smaller river or stream that joins the main river



confluence
The meeting point of two or more rivers or streams. The smaller river or stream is called a **tributary**.
