Capital letters for proper nouns. E.g. character names such as <i>Coco</i> .	
Capital letters and full stops.	
Neat handwriting as we are looking to give pen licenses out.	
Apostrophes for contracted words are used correctly. (don't, couldn't, won't etc)	
Subordinating conjunctions (if, because, when etc)	
Exciting adjectives to describe the characters and settings. (The <i>golden sun</i> shone in the <i>bright blue sky</i>)	
Powerful verbs to describe character actions. (The rabbits' hearts were <i>racing</i> .)	
Paragraphs 5 in total. (Beginning, build up, problem, resolution and ending)	
Use inverted commas to show speech and not used the criminal word said.	
Checked my work and edit it.
