L.O: To write a recipe

Today you will use the planning sheet from yesterday to write your revolting recipe.

You can write your recipe using the template provided (open separate document) or if you wish to challenge yourself you can write your recipe without.

Read the success criteria. These are all the things we will be looking for when we read your recipe. The success criteria is colour coded green, amber and red. Green are the easiest things to check and include whereas red are the most challenging. Use your coloured pens, pencils or highlighters to identify parts of your text which show each feature. For example, you could colour the 'imperative verbs' box in red, then use the **same colour** to underline all the imperative verbs in your text.

We have included some word mats to help you with your writing.
