

Syllable



Syllables


Every syllable must have a vowel.

You can determine how many syllable a word has based on how many vowels are in that word

s n a p b a s k e t

A Syllable may have 2 vowels if those vowels are a pair and one is silent (ea, ai, oa, a.e).

| Vowels | Consonants |
|-------------|---|
| A E I O U Y | B C D F G H J K L M N P Q R S T V W X Z |

In beyond, "y" is a consonant.
In hymn, "y" is a vowel.
